Purpose

Wearing a school uniform at Wilkins ensures all our students identify with being a member of Wilkins Public School. By wearing the school's uniform students and parents are making a statement of pride about being a member of Wilkins School community. Wearing of our school uniform also allows the community the opportunity to identify with our school. Appropriate footwear is essential to allow students to participate safely in school-based activities.

Implementation

- 1.1 All students are to wear their school uniform each day while at school, going to and from school and while participating in educational activities organised by the school.
- 1.2 Uniforms can be purchased and advice provided from the school P and C Association.
- 1.3 Good quality second hand jumpers and track pants may be available through the P and C.
- 1.4 Zone, Regional and State hoodies owned by students though their sporting success may be worn on sports days only, (Friday).

Changes to the Uniform

Small changes (like for like) to the uniform may be made by the uniform volunteers with consultation minuted due to, but not limited to;

- Companies going out of business
- Lack of quality of garments
- Better pricing but same quality
- Poor purchase of current stock
- Price rise of stock

Major changes need to go through the P and C for consultation, these include but are not limited to;

Colour changes

- Style changes
- Major omissions (not due to poor purchase by community)

The uniforms consist of:

Wilkins Public School uniforms are unisex.
White polo short or long sleeve shirt with school logo.
Bottle Green polo short sleeve shirt with school logo
Bottle green tunic or check tunic
Bottle green Jumper with school logo
Bottle green zip-up jacket with school logo
Bottle green skort or shorts.
Bottle green pants
Bottle green wide brimmed hat with logo.
Weather proof bottle green nylon jacket
Black or White socks
Green or black tights
Zone Hoodies on Friday ONLY
Year 6 Shirt Mon – Fri
Green Sports Shirt (sport days)

Shoes:

- Black shoes
- Black leather shoes or boots are preferred. Black joggers are acceptable
- It is important for children to wear shoes that provide sufficient protection for all activities
- Metal screw out studs are not permissible for sport
- On Muffi days Sun safe and WHS, considerations must be followed – Such as closed in shoes and T-Shirts as opposed to singlets

Hats:

 Our sun safety protocol is that students need to wear a Wilkins PS wide brimmed hat to school

- If a child is not wearing, a school hat for example a cap, or no hat they need to sit in the shade, under the eaves outside the office
- Hats must be taken on school excursions
